

MOODY IN EUROPE & GERMANY/SWITZERLAND SUMMER 2019

May 26th – July 28th OR June 10th – July 28th

Moody in Europe is a 9-week summer program that gives students the opportunity to travel through Italy, Switzerland, Germany and the Czech Republic while taking up to three courses. Moody in Germany/Switzerland is a 7-week trip that joins the Europe group after Italy. Participants in this trip can take up to two courses abroad. Both trips visit significant places of the early Church and the European Reformation. A voucher for one online course and one summer school course in Chicago are also included in both trips.

COST: approximately \$7400 for Europe Trip OR approximately \$5,400 for the shorter trip Pell-eligible, Loans and Payment Plan Available. Program cost includes accommodations, transportation in program, most meals, and two vouchers. **AIRFARE IS NOT INCLUDED IN COST**
