Emphasizing Bible courses, Moody in Israel provides students the opportunity to study the Bible in its geographical context. It also allows students to interact with modern Israeli culture and see evangelical ministries in Israel. Students may take 5 courses while abroad. The program also includes a voucher for one online course. Courses will include pre-course work and post-course work before and after the program.
