Moody in Italy – Fall 2017

September 8th – December 4th

Moody in Italy is a twelve-week fall program that gives students the opportunity to live and travel in Italy at Saints Bible Institute. Highlights of the program include a tour of Rome, Venice and Florence. Students may take four courses while abroad. The program also includes a voucher for one online course.

Cost: \$7950 (PELL grants may be applied to this program). Cost includes round trip airfare from Chicago, tuition, accommodations, most meals, and one online course voucher. It does not cover travel or room and board during the free week.
