Moody in Europe – Summer 2017

May 27th, 2017 – July 29th, 2017

Moody in Europe is a nine-week summer program that gives students the opportunity to travel through several different parts of Italy, Switzerland and Germany, visiting significant places of the early Church and European Reformations. Students may take three courses while abroad. The program also includes a voucher for two online courses and a voucher for one summer school course in Chicago or one J-Term course in Spokane.

Cost: *approximately \$8500 (in some cases, may be Pell-eligible).* Cost includes round trip airfare from Chicago, tuition, accommodations, most meals, and two course vouchers.
