**Please read the following notes carefully!**

1. **Payment Schedules:** There are three terms of payment available when enrolled as a pilot mechanic student in semesters 7 – 12.

a. Option 1: **Full semester payment** is due on the “Full Payment Due Date” for each semester as noted on the Student Cost Estimate Worksheet.

i. Reference example to the right. This is the default expectation unless otherwise enrolled below.

b. Option 2: Students may enroll in the optional **Moody Payment Plan** with MBI Student Accounts and make payments according to the schedule established on the Student Cost Estimate Worksheet, or as updated by Student Accounts.

- i. Students may choose to participate in the plan for one or both semesters. Students who have enrolled for the fall semester will be automatically enrolled for the spring semester, unless they opt out by November 30. Enrollment opens May 1 – June 30 for the fall semester, October 1 – November 30 for the spring semester. It is the student’s responsibility to enroll in the payment plan each Academic Year.
- ii. A \$50 enrollment fee is charged per semester. An additional \$10.00 fee is charged for late forms (forms submitted after the enrollment dates shown above). These fees are **non-refundable**. A \$25.00 fee is charged monthly for late payments or underpayments.

- iv. Additional payment amounts will be required for those flying more than the average calculated values. The final payment changes based on the actual flight hours flown during the semester. It will be calculated as the full balance due at the end of the semester PLUS your anticipated amount of flight charges remaining.
- v. Payment in full for each installment must be received by the payment deadline in order to remain on flight status each week.
- vi. Required payments will be reduced proportionally based on the amount of scholarships, grants and loans that are marked as “pending aid” on student accounts.
- vii. **Special note on outside aid and your payments**

Students must communicate Institute payment deadlines to any scholarship or sponsoring organization so that payment can be made by the due date for the first payment; which is July 1 for the fall semester and December 1 for the spring. If the scholarship funds are not received by the payment due date, students must make a regular payment at that time. Adjustments to your bill will be made when the actual check is received. Exceptions to this can only be made if the scholarship organization requires certification after classes begin **and** they provide an award letter before the first payment is due on their letterhead stating the amount of the scholarship award. Outside scholarships do not replace your regularly scheduled payments. They can, however, lower your overall monthly payment amount.

c. Options 3: Students may elect to follow FOM, **Flight Operations Manual policy** for payment

- i. All students will receive a monthly flight billing reflecting the actual number of hours flown and must maintain a minimum of \$1500 credit balance on their student account to be put on flight status each week.
- ii. There is no enrollment fee to use this option, but if at any time after the start of the semester your balance falls below \$0 you will be charged a \$25 late payment fee on a monthly basis.

2. **Methods of Payment:**

a. **Online card payment:** (Visa or MasterCard only)

b. **Automatic debit** from your bank account (ACH): Payments are taken directly from your bank account on the first of each month. Submit changes or corrections to [studentpaymentplan@moody.edu](mailto:studentpaymentplan@moody.edu) by the twenty-fourth of each month.

3. **Worksheet Notes:**

- a. The values indicated in this worksheet are based on the costs for the indicated academic year and reflect the flight time included for MBI course credit. Costs for future academic years will vary. While the specified number of flight hours for FAA certification may be less, course credit is dependent upon the completion of specified course requirements, including flight time and demonstrated skills proficiency detailed in the corresponding training course outline. Some students may require additional flight time in order to meet minimum standards for course completion and they will be charged for that additional time which will increase the student program costs.
- b. VA Education benefits only cover the number of hours listed for each flight course in the MBI Undergraduate Catalog, as represented on this worksheet. Most students need more time to obtain FAA certification and the cost will be incurred to the student as out of pocket expense.
- c. Moody reserves the right to adjust costs as necessary to reflect the operating cost of the aircraft in the event of significant price changes in supplies such as aviation fuel, though we are committed to keeping the costs as low as possible. This price increase is reflected through an aviation fuel surcharge that is billed monthly to all students corresponding to the number of flight hours they have flown. This additional fee is not covered by VA educational benefits and is considered an out of pocket expense. It is **not** included in the hourly rates published in the MBI Undergraduate Catalog or this worksheet.
- d. Plan on \$5000 plus course tuition for the aviation internship costs. Internship costs will vary depending on location, flight opportunities, and single of family participation. The internship may be taken any time after completion of the sophomore year when time allows.
- e. Insurance costs are shown for an individual student. Costs increase if the student elects coverage for student and spouse, student and family or student and children.
