Moody in Israel – Spring 2017

January 3, 2017 – March 26, 2017

Emphasizing Bible courses, Moody in Israel provides the student an opportunity to study the Bible in its geographical context. It also allows the student to interact with modern Israeli culture and see evangelical ministries in Israel. Students may take 4 courses while abroad. The program also includes a voucher for one online course. Courses will include pre-course work and post-course work before and after the program.

Cost: \$7900 Pell-eligible. Cost includes airfare, tuition, accommodations, most meals, a study tour and a voucher for one online class and one summer school course.
