Moody in Germany and Switzerland - Spring 2017
The 500th Anniversary of the Protestant Reformation
January 6, 2017 – March 30, 2017

Come celebrate the 500th anniversary of Luther's 95 theses and the beginning of the reformation in Europe. The Moody in Germany and Switzerland Program is designed to provide significant exposure to German culture and the Evangelical church in Germany. Students will be expected to attend a local church and be involved in ministry. Students may take up to four courses while abroad. The program also includes a voucher for two online courses. Courses will include pre-course work and post-course work before and after the program.

Cost: \$6400 - \$6600, Pell-eligible. Cost excludes airfare. Program cost includes tuition, accommodations, meals and program-planned travel expenses within Germany. Also included in the program cost are 2 vouchers for two online courses of your choice.
