

MOODY IN EUROPE

Summer 2018 | May 26th - July 31st

Moody in Europe is a nine-week summer program that gives students the opportunity to travel through several different parts of Italy, Switzerland and Germany, visiting significant places of the early Church and European Reformations. Students may take three courses while abroad. The program also includes a voucher for one online courses and one summer school course in Chicago or one J-Term course in Spokane.

Cost: *approximately* \$8500 (*in some cases, may be Pell-eligible*). Loans and Payment Plans Available. Program cost includes airfare from Chicago, accommodations, most meals, and two course vouchers.
