The Moody in Germany and Switzerland Program is designed to provide significant exposure to German culture and the Evangelical church in Germany. Students will be expected to attend a local church and be involved in ministry. Students may take up to four courses while abroad. The program also includes a voucher for two online courses. Courses will include pre-course work and post-course work before and after the program.

Cost: *\$6400 - \$6800*, Pell-eligible – Loans and Payment Plans Available. Cost <u>excludes airfare</u>. Program cost includes accommodations, meals and a reformation tour. Also included in the program cost are 2 vouchers for two online courses.
