

MOODY IN GERMANY AND SWITZERLAND

Summer 2018 | June 9th - July 31st

Moody in Switzerland and Germany is a seven-week summer program that gives students the opportunity to travel through several different parts of Switzerland and Germany, visiting significant places of the early Church and European Reformations. Students may take two courses while abroad. The program also includes a voucher for one online course and a voucher for one summer school course in Chicago or one J-Term course in Spokane.

Cost: approximately \$4950 - \$5200 (in some cases, may be Pell-eligible). Loans and Payment Plans Available.
