

MOODY IN ISRAEL

Spring 2018 | January 3rd – March 19th

Emphasizing Bible courses, Moody in Israel provides students the opportunity to study the Bible in its geographical context. It also allows students to interact with modern Israeli culture and see evangelical ministries in Israel. Students may take 5 courses while abroad. The program also includes a voucher for one online course. Courses will include pre-course work and postcourse work before and after the program.

Cost: \$7900 - \$8200 Pell-eligible - Loans and Payment Plan Available – Program cost includes airfare from Chicago, accommodations, most meals, a study tour and a voucher for one online class.
