SUMMER 2018 | June 20th – July 30th

Embarking on a 90 foot schooner off the coast of Greece, students will study the Bible in its geographical context on the same waters that the apostle Paul sailed. Students will also learn basic nautical skills and engage with different cultures as they develop a global theology. Student may take two courses while abroad. The program also includes a voucher for one online course and one summer school or J-term course. Courses will include pre-course work and post-course work before and after the program.
