Federal regulations require that colleges and universities monitor the academic progress of each applicant for financial assistance and certify that the applicant is making <u>satisfactory</u> <u>academic progress</u> toward earning his or her degree. Evaluation of each applicant's progress is completed at the end of each spring semester before financial aid funds are awarded and disbursed for any future term.

You have the right to appeal any decision of ineligibility for financial aid based on academic performance. Your appeal must be made in writing to the Satisfactory Academic Progress Appeals Committee and submitted to the Office of Financial Aid. Please note that an appeal based on your need for assistance or your lack of knowledge of the academic progress requirements to remain in good standing is not a valid justification for an appeal and will not be approved. An appeal should be based on some unusual situation or condition that prevented you from passing a sufficient number of courses attempted or maintaining the required GPA. Examples of extenuating circumstances are personal or family illness, or death of a relative.

1. Letter of explanation for requesting an appeal: You must provide a signed letter of explanation detailing the issues that affected your studies and successful completion of the courses attempted, and how these issues have been resolved.

#### 2. Required supporting documentation:

- If you or your immediate family member experienced a serious injury or illness, please attach a statement from your physician.
- If you experienced the death of an immediate family member, please attach statement from physician or other suitable documentation of this unfortunate situation.

The Satisfactory Academic Progress Committee will review your appeal and all supporting documentation. You will receive a notification that you have either been approved, approved with an academic plan, or that your request has been denied with any additional steps required.
