BI5531 Introduction to Theological Research and Digital Literacy, 3 credit hours

Course Description

The course is an introduction to theological research techniques, Bible software tools, writing skills, and provides an orientation to the development of a personal philosophy for the academic study of the Bible to the life of the contemporary church. A significant financial investment is required to purchase the Bible software.

Course Objectives

After completing this course, the student will be able to ...

- A. **Identify** and collect primary and secondary sources on a personal philosophy for the academic study of the Bible using information gathering skills (Reflection and Critique)
- B. **Apply** gathered research critically through the use of evaluative criteria by developing a working bibliography (Performance and Action)
- C. **Write** responsibly and ethically through the avoidance of plagiarism and the proper use of the Turabian footnote and bibliography citation style (Judgment and Design)
- D. **Utilize** at least 50% of the features of the [Logos Bible Software 5] required for this course, especially those related to one's personal philosophy for the academic study of the Bible with regard to the contemporary church (Knowledge and Understanding)

Course Textbook(s) and/or Supplemental Information

Assignments (what student does for a grade)

Guideline for the Discussion Board: Post your initial response to the discussion question by mid-week (Friday, 11:59pm CST). Then read and respond to at least **ONE** of your classmates' initial posts by the end of the week (Monday, 11:59pm CST).

Standard for Written Papers: All papers must be in Turabian style. Each page should be approximately 300 words, 12-pt. Times New Roman font on double-spaced lines with 1" margins. (Therefore, a 2-page paper is approximately 600 words; a 3-page paper is approximately 900 words, etc.).

Note that footnotes should be in a smaller font, such as 10 pt. (Use MS Word's function under its "References" tab to "Insert Footnote" to make this process automatic. Do NOT depend on Word's autoformatting to correctly format in Turabian style, however.)

Assignment 1-1 Chart of Initial References: Put together a ONE page chart of resources located in Moody's library catalog (one book), ATLA - or other Moody database (one journal article), and another online resource (non-Moody-housed) of your own choosing (book, article, or webpage) addressing the topic of a theology of work.

Assignment 1-2 Summary of Findings from Logos: Write a ONE page summary of what you found in Logos 5 by doing a search, using the general search bottom, for a *theology of work*; and for doing a word study, using the Bible Word Study tool, on the phrase "labor and work".

Assignment 2-1 Bibliography Topic: Write a ONE page description of your bibliography topic (from Assignment 1-1) dealing with a *theology of work*.

Assignment 2-2 Why Study Theology? - Paper: Write a TWO page paper describing why you are studying theology.

Assignment 2-3 Twenty Features of Logos Chart: Fill out the ONE page chart (chart provided) dealing with twenty feature of Logos 5.

Assignment 3-1 Faithful Theologian Paper, Part 1: Write a TWO page paper categorizing the first four characteristics of a faithful theologian.

Assignment 3-2 Footnote Paper: Write a ONE page paper (two paragraphs) that shows how to footnote.

Assignment 4-1 Faithful Theologian Paper, Part 2: Write a TWO page paper categorizing the next three characteristics of a faithful theologian.

Assignment 4-2 Bibliography Project - Books: Construct a ONE page bibliography by locating ten books (chose from single author works, collections of essays, and reference works [at least one from each category]) dealing with your chosen topic within a theology of work.

Assignment 5-1 Characteristics of a Pastor-Scholar Paper: Write a TWO page paper reflecting on three or four of the twelve lessons for a scholar as the (frustrated) pastor from the assigned video.

Assignment 5-2 Bibliography Project - Journal Articles: Construct a ONE page bibliography by locating ten journal articles dealing with your chosen topic within a theology of work. You are to follow proper bibliography format.

Assignment 6-1 Tentmaking Chart: Put together a ONE page chart using the scriptures on work and tentmaking from the assigned reading by using the passage guide tool in Logos 5 (make sure you use commentaries and Bible dictionaries for your information).

Assignment 6-2 Bibliography Project and Review: Edit and combine all your previous work done on your research topic dealing with a theology of work.

Assignment 7-1 Research Paper on Your Personal Philosophy of Academic Study of the Bible: Edit and combine all your previous work done on your personal philosophy for the academic study of the Bible.
